fruit driven, aromatic, stylish

castillo del Moro £3.75/£5.00/£14.50

A tangy crisp and citrusy dry white wine from Spain. Deliciously moorish!

albarino, castle de bouza (spain) £24.50

produced by a co-operative of just 5 vine yard owners, castel de bouza has access to great fruit from which they make classic albarino. Bright, citrusy and minerally on the nose with a crisp rieling like character on the palate. Brilliant seafood or shellfish partner

sauvignon blanc, sherwood estate (NZ) £23.50

new Zealand provides us with the world's most characteristic flavours, ripe, tropical fruit mingles with gooseberry and asparagus hints

sancerre, chateau de sancerre (france) 2006 £39.00

full of elegance this Loire sauvignon has pure citrus aromas that lead to fine and long finish

viognier, la campagne £19.50

the northern Rhone variety is becoming less rare and is noewestablished in the south of France. As the vines mature, they produce wines with an even more of that classic peachy – apricot flavor

light, crisp, refreshing

sauvignon valle los espinos (chile) 2007 £4.20/5.50/£16.00

refreshing, crisp and slightly fragrant sauvignon, endlessly quaffable and ideal with spicy or strong flavoured dishes

pinot grigio bella mondella figlia (Italy) £4.25/£5.65/£16.00

if you are looking for light crisp and refreshing then stop....you have found it! This delicious mouthwatering wine is delicate, citrusy and dry with a tangy flavour

nostros sauvignon blanc reserve (chile) £18.50

sourced from chile's premium sauvignon blanc region, Casablanca, this is a pure exuberantly fruity sauvignon packed full of grassy tropical fruit. Instantly refreshing and moreish with a lovely tangy finish

chenin blanc raats original (s.a) £21.50

packed with succulent flavours of apple, pineapple and citrus with hints of honeysuckle and orange blossom and lovely minerality bright and tasty, it is made without oak to preserve the grapes 'original' vibrant fresh fruit character

chablis, paul deloux (france) vintage 2006 £25.50

classic flinty, steely dry chablis with crisp apple fruit and a long minerally finish

complex, rich, elegant

chardonnay, costa vera (chile) £16.50

a crisp, underwooded style of chardonnay with lively lemony fruit character and a refreshing pear and apple finish

Cloudy bay chardonnay (australia) £42.00

the subtle scent of lemon blossom is balanced by the aromatics of cashew nuts. the rich, yet refined palate has a delicious minerally and creamy complexity. a classic chardonnay from the premium cloudy bay winery

torres esmeralda (spain) 2007 £5.00/£6.65/£19.50

off dry grapey and fragrant, ram packed with luscious ripe fruit

sant' helena pinot grigio collio, vigneti fantinel (italy) £26.50

this is how all pinot grigio should be! Full rounded apple fruit flavours backed by a hint of almond and hazelnuts

kells edge Riesling- gewürztraminer £15.50

a medium styled delightly floral, grapey character from the blend of Riesling with the ripe and rich gewurztraimer

red wine

soft, juicy, medium bodied

castillo del moro (spain) 2003 £3.75/£5.00/£14.50

Silky soft, Spanish red with warming,plump, plumpy fruits ideal alone or with cahcutrie

Merlot los espinos(chile) £4.20/£5.50/£16.00

Succulent red fruit bursting with supple bramble and blackberries. fresh and elegant on the palate with a beautifully delicate finish

rioja luis canas (spain) £5.00/£6.65/£19.50

enveloped with sumptuous fruit from start to finish. the oak lends soft and smoky hints which combined with the singing fruit delivers a stunning, very moreish, young rioja

Terra Barossa shiraz (australia) 2005 £26.50

Complex characters of bitter chocolate, plum, anise and raspberries combine with an underlying spiciness to give a beautifully balanced, rich and creamy red wine. A moreish finish with lingering notes of chocolate –a real treat. The perfect wine to be enjoyed on its own or with grilled red meat, pizza and stews.

smooth, mellow, decadent

cabernet sauvignon costa vera (chile) £4.20/£5.50/£16.00

deliciously cherry filled and exuberant with ripe plummy fruit and hints of cassis and chocolate

veramonte merlot reserva £18.50

casablanca valley reserva (chile) 2006

dark rich merlot from the cool Casablanca valley giving depth and richness unrivalled at this level

saint emilion-montagne (france) £29.00

beautifully ripe, dark berry fruit characteristics this wine. Medium bodied with soft, supple style and s warm savoury finish

faustino I rioja gran reserv (spain) 1996 £38.00

this wine is matured for 25-30 months in american oak barrels before a minimum of 3 years in bottle. mature, velvety-smooth in the mouth and with great complexity. in a bottle with the traditional wire covering; the flagship of the faustino range. top flight rioja full of seamless creamy blackcurrant flavours

cabernet sauvignon Suck fizzle (western Australia) £41.00

classic cabernet aromas of red and black berry fruits, sweet mint, freshly rubbed herbs and bay leaf mingle with oak characters of mocha, chocolate and cedar.

bold, spicy, warming

shiraz berri estate (australia) £16.00

dark bramble fruits, a touch of pepper and a hint of oak mark this out as classic aussie shiraz

montepulciano d'abruzzo zero (italy) £22.50

this is a rich deeply savoury, complex version of that old Italian classic, packed with dark, herby black fruits and a hint of spice and smoke

malbec familia zuccardi (argentina) £21.50

argentina's malbec is a great partner with the steaks that have made argetntina a gastronomic destination. This wine made from the lower yielding grapes, is concentrated and rich yet supple and appealing. Lots of plummy fruit and character with hints of spice and mocha

zinfandel old vine lodi county, ravenswood (2005) £22.50

serious zinfandel that starts off medium bodied but has a finish that builds and builds(usa vintage '2005)

chateauf-neuf-du-pape, chateau saint andre (2006) £45.00

a classically smooth, mellow wine with a long, lingering finish, intense spicy berry fruits with balanced oak and a rich earthy character. a wine which is no stranger to winning gold medals! (france)

barolo, lo zoccolaio (italy)2003 £43.00

this superior wine has been matured in the traditional way for 3 years in large oak barrels before bottling. a wine with great complexity and smoothness, big gusty black cherry and dark chocolate style with a long warming afterglow
