## White wine

### *fruit driven, aromatic, stylish*

<b>castillo del Moro</b> (Spain)	£3.45/£4.50/£13.00
A tangy crisp and citrusy dry white wine from Spain. Deliciously Moorish!	
<b>viognier, la champagne</b>	£19.00
the northern Rhone variety is becoming less rare and is now established in the south of France. As the vines mature, they produce wines with an even more of that classic peachy – apricot flavor	
<b>albarino, castle de bouza</b> (Spain)	£22.00
produced by a co-operative of just 5 vine yard owners, castle de bouza has access to great fruit from which they make classic albarino. Bright, citrusy and mineral on the nose with a crisp rieling like character on the palate. Brilliant seafood or shellfish partner	
<b>sauvignon blanc, sherwood estate</b> (NZ)	£22.00
New Zealand provides us with the world's most characteristic flavours, ripe, tropical fruit mingles with gooseberry and asparagus hints	
<b>sancerre, chateau de sancerre</b> (France) 2006	£35.00
full of elegance this Loire sauvignon has pure citrus aromas that lead to a fine and long finish	

### *light, crisp, refreshing*

<b>sauvignon valle los espinos</b> (Chile) 2007	£3.75/£5.00/£14.50
refreshing, crisp and slightly fragrant sauvignon, endlessly quaffable and ideal with spicy or strong flavoured dishes	
<b>pinot grigio bella mondella figlia</b> (Italy)	£3.75/£5.00/£14.50
if you are looking for light crisp and refreshing then stop.....you have found it! This delicious mouthwatering wine is delicate, citrusy and dry with a tangy flavour	
<b>nostros sauvignon blanc reserve</b> (Chile)	£17.00
sourced from Chile's premium sauvignon blanc region, Casablanca, this is a pure exuberantly fruity sauvignon packed full of grassy tropical fruit. Instantly refreshing and moreish with a lovely tangy finish	
<b>chenin blanc raats original</b> (S.A)	£19.00
packed with succulent flavours of apple, pineapple and citrus with hints of honeysuckle and orange blossom and lovely minerality bright and tasty, it is made without oak to preserve the grapes 'original' vibrant fresh fruit character	
<b>chablis, paul deloux</b> (France) vintage 2006	£24.00
classic flinty, steely dry chablis with crisp apple fruit and a long mineral finish	

### *complex, rich, elegant*

<b>kells edgeriesling-gewurztraminer</b>	£13.00
a medium styled delightfully floral, grapey character from the blend of riesling with the ripe and rich gewurztraminer	
<b>chardonnay, costa vera</b> (Chile)	£15.00
a crisp, underwooded style of chardonnay with lively lemony fruit character and a refreshing pear and apple finish	
<b>torres Esmeralda</b> (Spain)	£4.25/£5.65/£16.50
off dry grapey and fragrant, ram packed with luscious ripe fruit	
<b>sant' helena pinot grigio collio, vigneti fantinel</b> (Italy) 2006	£24.50
this is how all pinot grigio should be! Full rounded apple fruit flavours backed by a hint of almond and hazelnuts	
<b>Cloudy bay chardonnay</b>	£38.00
The subtle scent of lemon blossom is balanced by the aromatics of cashew nuts, the rich, yet refined palate has a delicious mineral complexity	

## Red wine

### *soft, juicy, medium bodied*

<b>Castillo del moro</b> (Spain)	£3.45/£4.50/£13.00
Silky soft Spanish red with warming, plump, plummy fruits ideal alone or with cactus	
<b>Sierra grande merlot</b> (Chile)	£3.75/£5.00/£14.50
soft and subtle with silky spiced plums and cedar fruit. A mini St Emilion pinot noir from northern Italy	
<b>rioja bodega artesa</b> (Spain)	£4.50/£6.00/£17.50
softly fruited, mellow and rounded. This modern style will have you coming back for more	
<b>santa caterina pinot nero collio</b>	£19.00
wild raspberries with a touch of exotic spice burst from the glass in this amazing	
<b>yarraman estate black cypress shiraz</b> (Australia) 2005	£24.00
some of Australia's greatest wines come from the Hunter Valley and this is no exception. The grapes from vines of over 35 years of age are fermented in open-top vats, then transferred to French oak barrels for 14 months further maturation. A full bodied wine ripe berry fruit and peppery, subtle tannin	

### *smooth, mellow, decadent*

<b>cabernet sauvignon costa vera</b> (Chile)	£3.90/£5.00/£15.00
deliciously cherry filled and exuberant with ripe plummy fruit and hints of cassia and chocolate	
<b>veramonte merlot reserva</b> Casablanca valley reserva (Chile) 2006	£17.00
dark rich merlot from the cool Casablanca valley giving depth and richness unrivalled at this level	
<b>saint emilion-montagne</b> (France)	£24.00
beautifully ripe, dark berry fruit characteristics this wine. Medium bodied with soft, supple style and a warm savoury finish	
<b>faustino I rioja gran reserv</b> (Spain) 1996	£34.00
this wine is matured for 25-30 months in American oak barrels before a minimum of 3 years in bottle. Mature, velvety-smooth in the mouth and with great complexity. In a bottle with the traditional wire covering; the flagship of the Faustino range. Top flight Rioja full of seamless creamy blackcurrant flavours	
<b>robert mondavi cabernet sauvignon</b> (Napa valley) 2001	£55.00
premium offering from California's legendary winemaker. Appealing red and dark berry fruit character reminiscent of cherries and currants, backed by warm vanilla tones on a long smooth finish. Some aging in French and American oak barrels also adds to the flavour spectrum	

### *bold, spicy, warming*

<b>shiraz berri estate</b> (Australia)	£14.50
dark bramble fruits, a touch of pepper and a hint of oak mark this out as classic Aussie Shiraz	
<b>montepulciano d'abruzzo zero</b> (Italy)	£18.50
this is a rich deeply savoury, complex version of that old Italian classic, packed with dark, herby black fruits and a hint of spice and smoke	
<b>malbec familia zuccardi</b> (Argentina)	£19.50
Argentina's malbec is a great partner with the steaks that have made Argentina a gastronomic destination. This wine made from the lower yielding grapes, is concentrated and rich yet supple and appealing. Lots of plummy fruit and character with hints of spice and mocha	
<b>zinfandel old vine lodi county, ravenswood</b> (2005)	£19.50
serious zinfandel that starts off medium bodied but has a finish that just builds	
<b>chateauneuf-du-pape, chateau saint andre</b> (2006)	£35.00
a classically smooth, mellow wine with a long, lingering finish, intense spicy berry fruits with balanced oak and a rich earthy character. A wine which is no stranger to winning gold medals!	
<b>barolo, lo zoccolaio</b> (Italy) 2003	£44.00
this superior wine has been matured in the traditional way for 3 years in large oak barrels before bottling. A wine with great complexity and smoothness, big gusty black cherry and dark chocolate style with a long warming afterglow
